Main intake late January* –26 week course

The Rural Servicing Programme combines theory with practical “hands-on” experience. The training includes local and block courses and workplace training, both on-farm and with representatives in the rural servicing industry.

location

This course is offered throughout the country at various Agriculture New Zealand locations subject to numbers. Workplace training will take place at a PGG Wrightson or other rural servicing business location.

your career

Career options include working in the “Rural Servicing” field, selling farm motorbikes or irrigation equipment or working in the retail side of a vet practice. If you are offered employment during your training, you can continue to study with Agriculture New Zealand until you gain the National Certificate in Rural Servicing Level 3. Ongoing study options with the Agriculture ITO are then available.

cost

\$1500. You may be eligible for a student allowance and/or student loan through Studylink. You will incur some costs such as travel to the site of training, including some national block courses.
