## **General Information/Disclaimer**

Welcome to the first (and most likely the last!) Muzzle Station horse sale. 18 unbroken yearlings, two year olds, three year olds and four year old will be offered for sale.

These horses are for sale due to the fact that we have more than enough replacement station hacks available for our own use and it is very difficult to sell single horses from the Muzzle itself with our access issues. That is why we decided to walk the young horses the 50 kilometres out to Kaikoura so that they are much more readily available to buyers.

Muzzle has been breeding horses since the early 1980's and we still use horses for all our cattle work on the Station. Horses we have bred have jumped clear around Badminton, played polo in the USA, done the Otago Cavalcade and carried nervous children around pony club.

Our horses are all born on the hill where their mothers run with the stallion throughout the year. They are usually handled before weaning whilst still on their mothers and then all given a thorough handling when they are weaned, branded and castrated. We try and make this process as positive as an experience possible. After a week or so at the homestead they are turned out onto very steep country with an older nanny mare and usually remain in their age groups until they are brought back in for another handling and a drench a year or so later.

Our philosophy is to breed tough, sound and sensible horses from proven mares and stallions that will perform in many disciplines.

### **Transport**

Transport will be arranged by Muzzle Station at the purchasers cost. No Horse Floats PLEASE. These horses will have all had a short stock truck ride to get down the main road to Muzzle Farm. Although all care will be taken, Muzzle will take no responsibility for any injuries/damage caused after the fall of the hammer or during transport.

All persons viewing horses do so at their own risk. All horses are UNBROKEN.

Lot 1 has always shown an upfront friendly nature and bears a close resemblance to Tim Price's Southpaw. Should mature over 16hh.

Four year old Bay Mare.

Lot 2 is a very tall elegant mare with a double cross of Aberconway. Oozes jumping blood out of a full sister to Rodney Powell's Zinzan II (Short listed for British eventing team Beijing Olympics 2008) this family is a consistent producer of successful horses and this mare is the 6<sup>th</sup> generation to be bred by us.

### Rosamota

Black Muzzle Station bred TB mare by **Natural Star**. A wonderful honest hack on the station for many years, very sensible and sound.

### Estella

Bay Muzzle Station bred mare 16.1 by **Tirana/Simoon (Shamal)**. A stunning always admired powerful mare, champion in the show ring, schooled to 1.10m. Very honest and never reached full potential due to rider's lack of ability and time. A full sister to Rodney Powell's Zinzan II who won Boekelo international 3\* and was shortlisted for the Beijing Olympics.

### Big Rosie

A big strong tough mare that trekked and show jumped. By a Cleveland Bay cross stallion out of a Gisbourne Ihungia Station mare. Big Rosie's first foal is a reliable quiet station hack. Always leaves a similar type

### Caseys Comet

Bay Muzzle Station bred mare by **Natural Star** out of a Bluff Station Mare. A polo pony and station hack with plenty of spirit. Has left some very kind and successful horses.

### Girly

Chestnut TB mare by **Senor Pete** out of Riverain (**Tawfiq**) Approx. 15.3. A slow racehorse that was very quiet to ride, from a family of good racehorses who were always sound and often went on to other pursuits after racing.

### Ellie

A very tall classy ½ draft mare belonging to Rick Denton. From a family of hunters and jumpers Ellie was a wonderful stockhorse. Her first foal by Rick Denton's Chief is going very well.

### Simoon

Bay Muzzle Station bred mare, 16.3hh by **Shamal** out of Celmisia (TB). Descending from a long line of top hunters and jumpers, Simoon was only ridden briefly before injury forced her into breeding. She left top international eventer Zinzan II and several other kind and well preformed offspring. Tina Nimmo acquired the first member of this family in the 1960's.

### Jess

Brown ½ Clyde mare belonging to Mandy and Rob Stanley, Jess trekked extensively before being retired to Muzzle Station. A super kind mare Jess's first foal by Kincapple Lad is just about to start his first hunting season with Alison and Boota Green in the Waikato. Her Second foal is about to embark on a dressage career in Auckland.

### **Tina/The Dun**

Dun Muzzle Station bred mare by **Natural Star** out of a Bluff Station mare. A champion polo mare who played top level polo all around NZ for a very long time. A highly regarded tough little mare whose first 3 foals are all playing polo. A wonderful tough family.

### **Smite**

Chestnut TB mare by Straight Strike/Riverain (Tawfiq)

A winner of 4 races, Smite has left race winners and some very promising sporthorses. This family has been with Tina Nimmo since the early 1980's and are always sound, correct and dual purpose horses.
