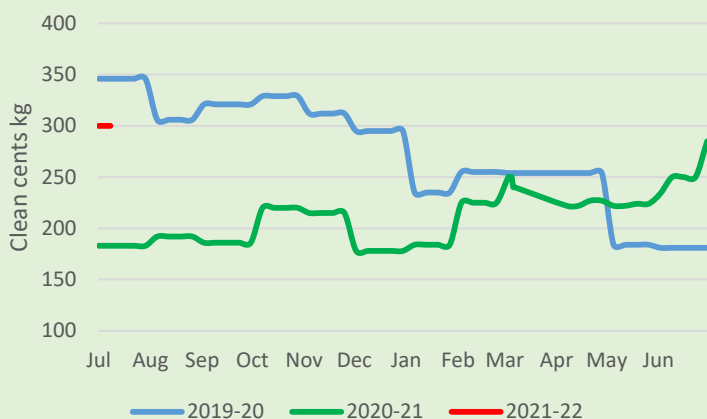

Commentary

The first wool sale of the 2021-22 season opened strongly following the same positive trend from the end of season sale two weeks ago.

The stand out types for the season opener were the early pre-Lamb shorn styles from all breeds typically showing good colour, style and good tensile strength.

After a period of fairly subdued competition for the mid-micron types in recent months, the market became very animated today with best style lots up to 15% dearer.
