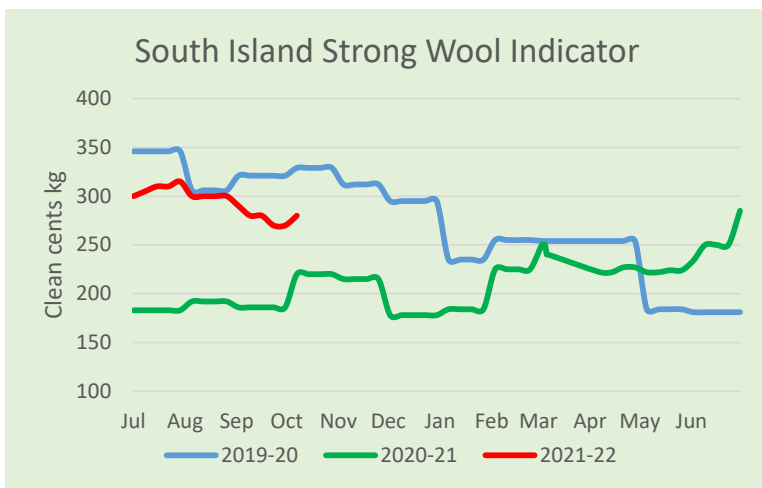

## Commentary

There is still a steady flow through the wool pipeline but logistics and global shipping issues continue to prove challenging for exporters.
