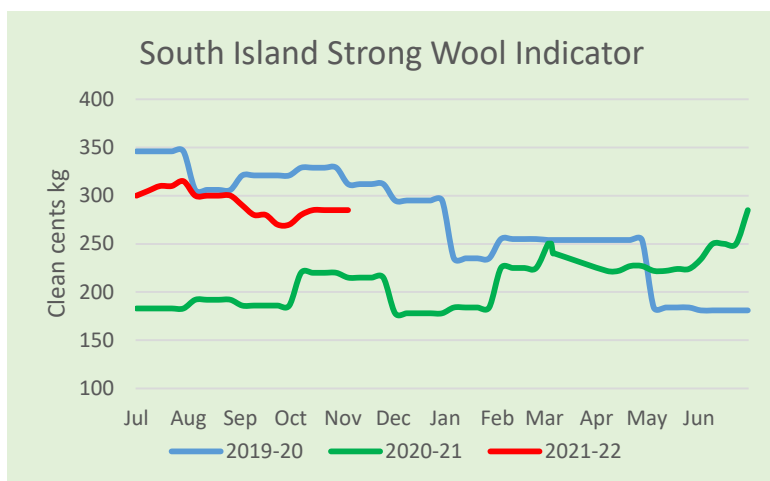

Commentary

The 6750 bale offering saw a good balance of mainly hogget wools from all sheep breeds. A strong feature of the sale was the renewed interest for the sub 25 micron types which saw meaningful lifts. The merino market saw some corrections especially in the sub 17.5 micron range in line with global markets. The crossbred sector be best quoted as sellers favour, with some speciality lots fetching strong premiums.
