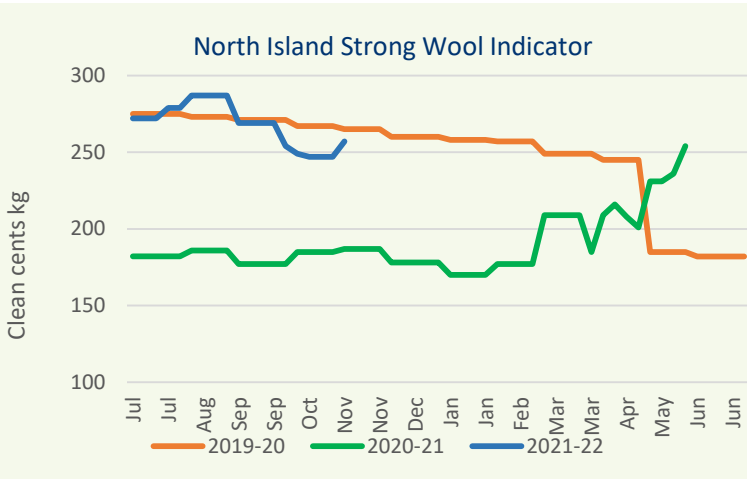

Whilst the sale began with a little hesitancy this morning, by the time the PGG Wrightson catalogue was marketed it had grown a new lease of life. Some very fine hogget wool lines sold well with the other hogget micron ranges on par with previous weeks. A number of big Taihape station lines were marketed today by PGG Wool and sold to very strong bidding as well. The stand out lots today were the good coloured fleece and strong second shear wools that sold to good demand on the back of very limited amounts of wool available at present.
