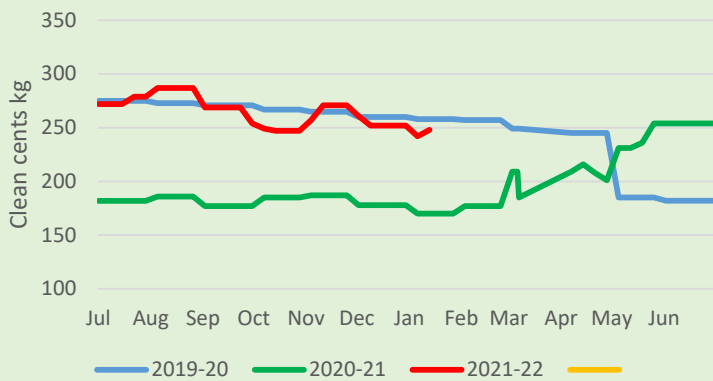

### Commentary,

The wool sale in Napier this morning could be quoted as "sold in sellers favour." There was upbeat and spirited bidding coming from the floor today which resulted in most better wool types increasing in value. A gap of about 50 cents now represents the difference in price between better coloured fleece wools and those with higher colour readings. Lambs wool was also chased along as buyers reacted to the smaller than normal quantities that are currently available.
