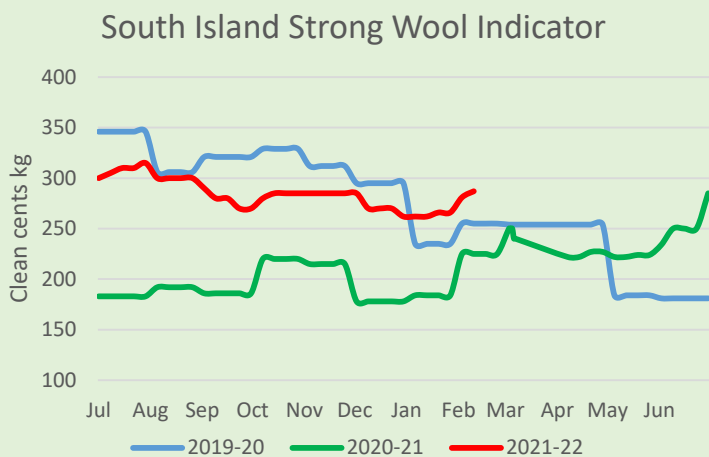

Commentary

There was a much stronger tone to the market compared to the previous South Island sale a week ago, with most types of Crossbred fleece, 2nd shear and Lamb's wool in sellers favour. Interestingly, it was more of the poorer style wools that fetched the strongest bidding in the sale room. A limited offering of new seasons Lamb's wool also saw active bidding, with the finer micron ones being most affected.
