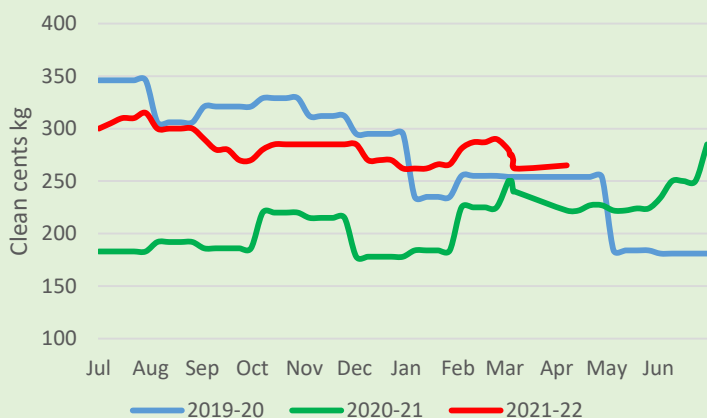

Commentary

There was a stronger tone to the Crossbred market today compared to the previous South Island sale two weeks ago, as buyers focused mainly on the better style wools with low levels of VM.

Best style and finer than 30 micron Lamb's wool also found buyers' favour.

The struggling market continues to be challenged with continued dominated offerings of summer shorn ewe wools that have been environmentally affected this season with higher colour readings than normal.
