

A large South Island offering for the final wool sale of the 2022-23 wool season included some superb Otago Perendale types catalogued by PGG Wrightson, which drew very strong support from the buyers, resulting in prices in excess of \$4.20/Kg Clean. Any poorer prepared crossbred types were discounted, although the best of these received support similar to our previous sale 3 weeks ago.

A large offering of mid-micron wools from Canterbury and Marlborough received weaker support as anticipated, with only the finest of types selling well. Coarser mid-micron wools were in general passed in failing to meet grower's reserves.
