**Crossbred Oddments** 



The first wool sale of the season has largely picked up from where it finished for most average style wools offered at the last South Island sale.

The key points of interest was the strong demand for the best style pre-lamb shorn and well-prepared crossbred fleece which is now reaching price levels not seen since December 2016. With the bulk of the second shear wool currently coming forward in the Nth Island we have seen

the crossbred 2<sup>nd</sup> shear market cheaper on a limited offering.

A good offering of Mid-micron fleece saw cautious bidding and while a slight improvement, most lots were passed in, failing to meet growers' reserves.
