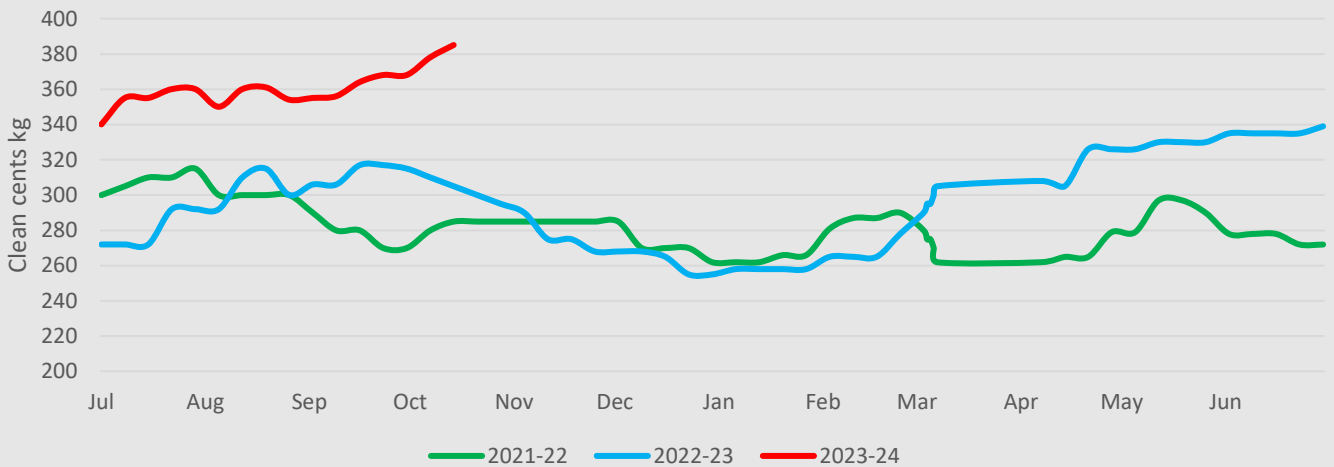

A quality offering of all wool breeds saw strong support from a full bench of buyers. Crossbred wool values continued their march into new ground with all styles lifting on a rising tide, with the better prepared and best style wools most affected. Merino wools also found renewed favour, especially with the NZ dollar weakening against the green back. Mid-micron wools were largely unchanged from recent sales.
