

Extremely strong bidding, full participation from all the trade and minimal passings has seen the Wool sale in Napier result in another market indicator increase. Whilst there were a few holes in the prices for shorter higher coloured wools, all other wool types sold extremely well. There has been some good interest from overseas and with sales being made the market has reacted accordingly. Preparation has let some lambs wool down with the result of not achieving
