

The South Island sale saw the market cheaper for most crossbred types and styles compared to recent weekly wool sales in Christchurch. Significant volumes of wool have come forward from Southland that have exceeded rostered forecasts which has allowed buyers to be more selective, especially with Lamb's wool. A nominal selection of mid-micron wool however bucked the sediment on the day and sold well above valuation levels.
