Today's Napier wool auction delivered mixed results, with the rising NZD against the USD dampening export demand and putting pressure on prices. Superior wools failed to reach the highs of the previous sale, reflecting a case of supply and demand. In contrast, bellies and pieces saw a modest lift. Average to poor-quality wools held firm, maintaining previous price levels. A high pass-in rate of 18% due to growers holding firm on their expectations for their premium wool. Overall, the strong NZD remains a key challenge for exporters
