

The first sale of the new wool season saw prices ease across all types. Poor wools held relatively firm, likely due to supply and demand, with good coloured 2nd shear making up 40% of the offering. A few remaining lamb lines exceeded expectations, attracting strong interest despite its poor colour and high VM. However, insufficient skirting of the better lines continues to reduce their appeal and value. Overall, the market opened cautiously.
