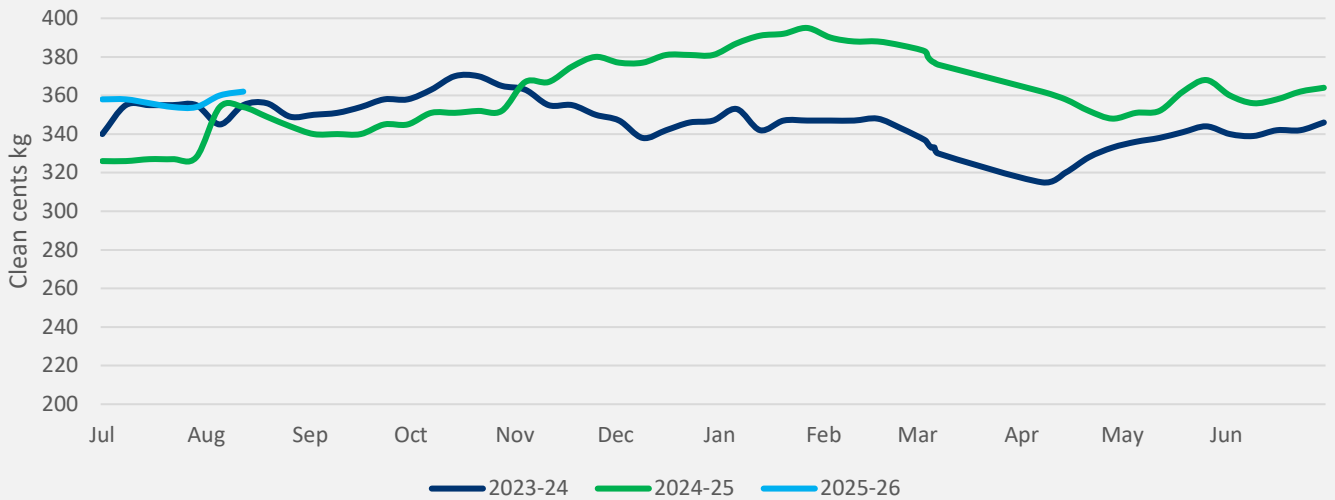

An excellent offering of pre-Lamb shorn fleece and oddments saw the market improve for most Xbd types, with the well prepared and best styles most affected. Several lots exceeding 400c/kg clean.

The mid-micron market saw price levels consolidate after a period of rapid price increases in recent sales which has been seen as a positive, providing some stability and confidence along the wool pipeline.
