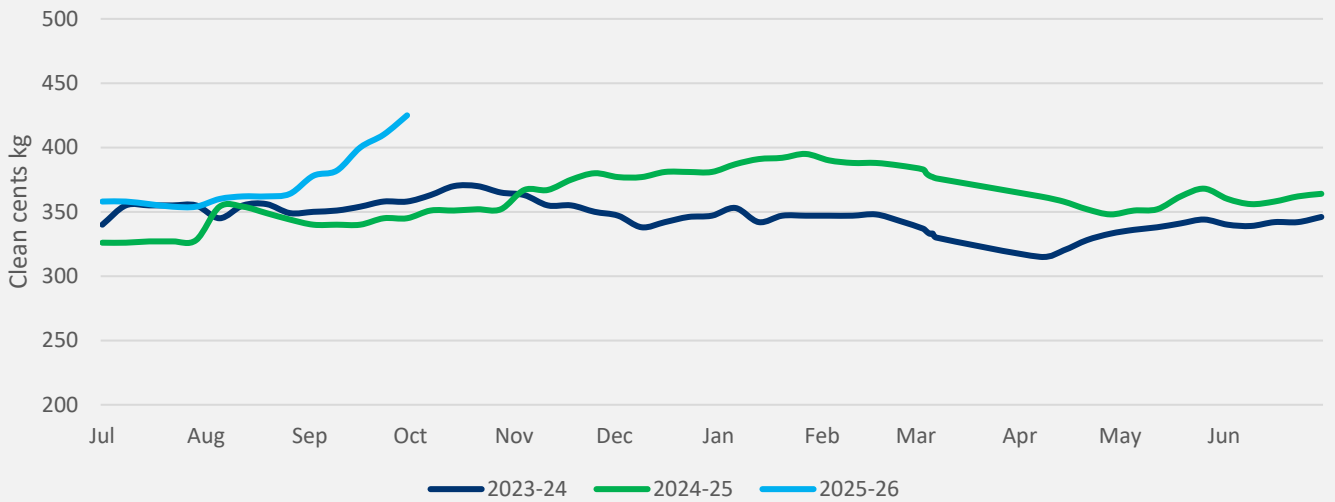

Bidding at times was extreme, with buyers having to fill immediate orders into China. A major Australian based wool exporting company dominated the floor for most fine wool types.
