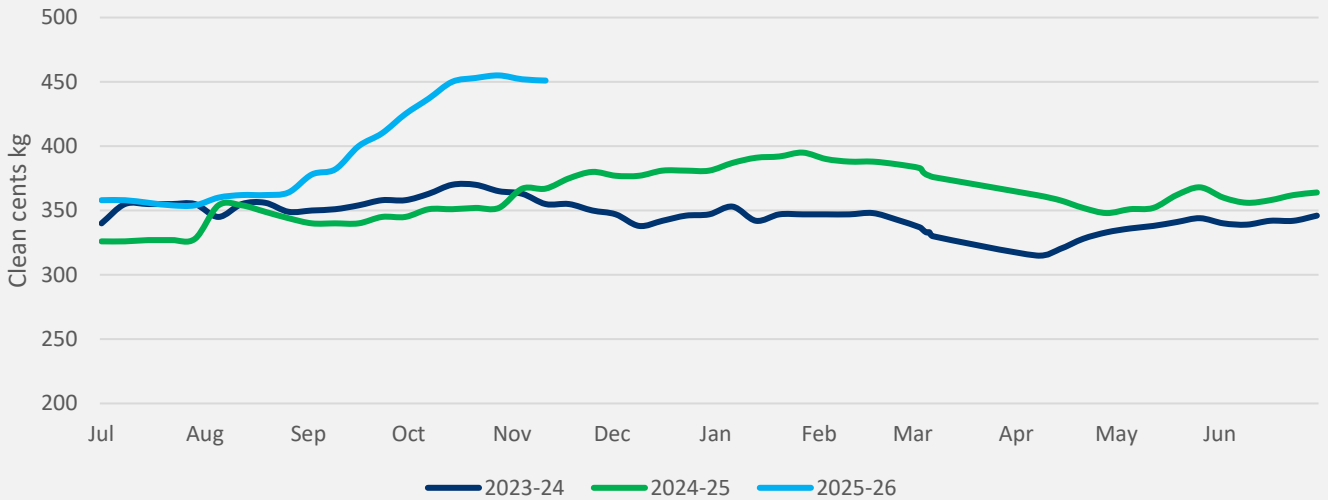

The market saw the Xbd market largely in buyers favour for the better style wools but cheaper for the less stylish lots. The merino market has rebounded after sharp drop offs in recent weeks, buyers aware that in NZ, the fine wool season is nearing its end. A mixed offering of mid-micron wool saw traders' take a less urgent approach after filling shortfall consignments.
