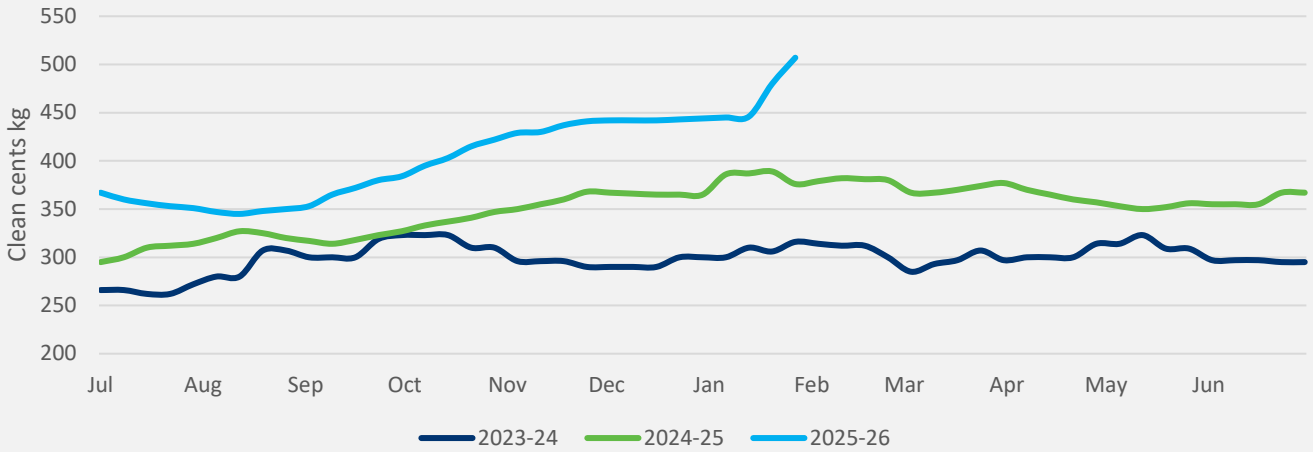

The N30 sale saw further gains as exporter demand remains competitive. Prices continue to push into new territory, with shears and fleece types averaging lifts of around 60 cents clean, reflecting sustained offshore interest and shortage of wool. Competition was evident, with confident bidding supporting all key types, while finer lambs wool remained a standout, with 27-micron lines reaching mid to high 500 cents/kg clean. The results of this sale confirm the bullish momentum established at the opening sale, reinforcing positive sentiment as exporters continue to secure volume for ongoing export programs. **Regards, Annabel Busby, Appraisal and Procurement Coordinator**
