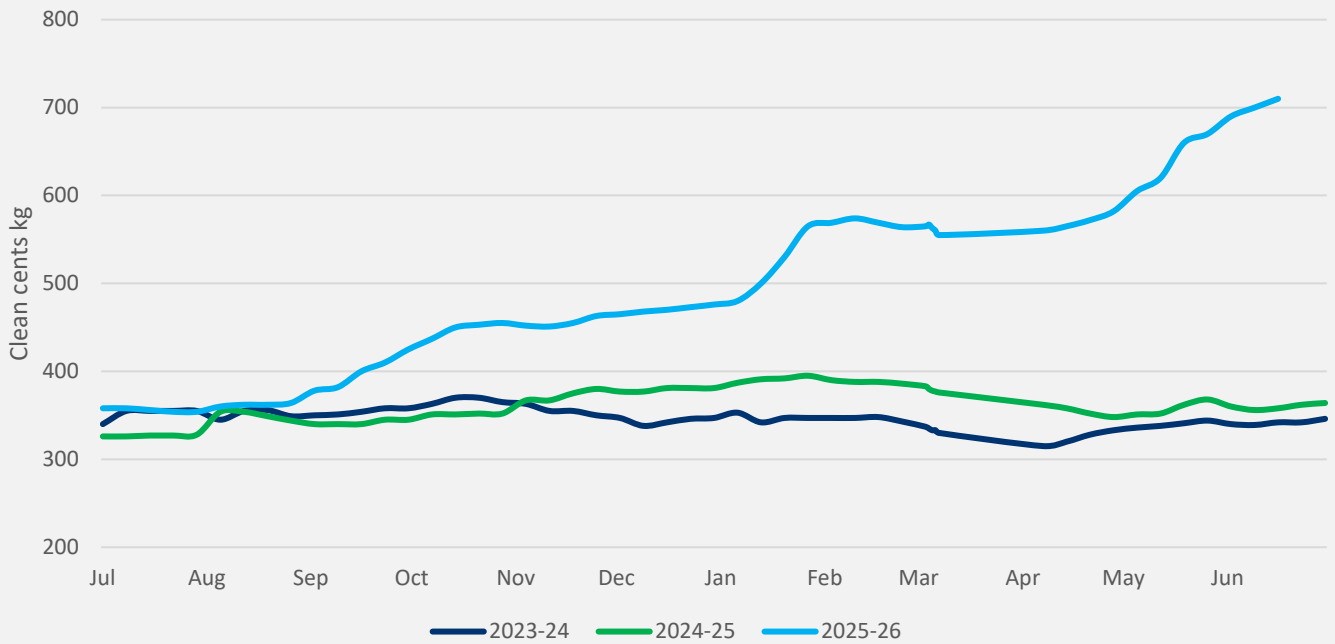

“ The national wool market continued its upward momentum, recording significant price increases across all major wool types compared with the previous national auction held two weeks ago. Strong buyer competition was evident, with a full bench of participants actively competing to secure supply amid constrained volumes on offer. Crossbred wool prices have now more than doubled since the start of the season, an unprecedented lift in recent market history. A high-quality offering of new-season mid-micron wool attracted particularly strong bidding interest, with prices approaching near-record levels.
