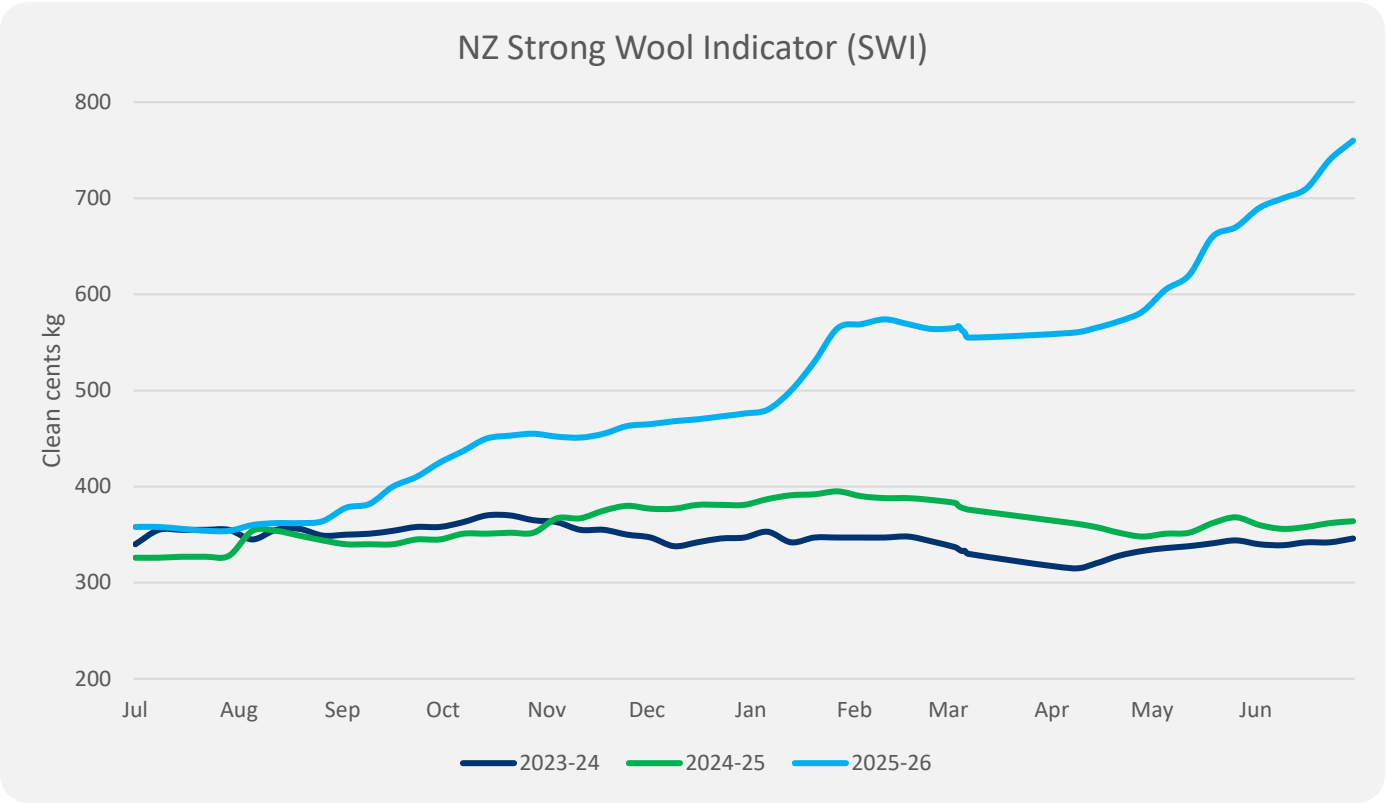

“ The last sale of the season marked a strong finish to what has been an exceptional year for all wool types and styles, with prices reaching historic highs. Buyer demand remains robust, supported by strong global participation, with China continuing to drive renewed interest in natural wool fibres. The outlook for the new season is positive, particularly with high-quality pre-lamb shorn clips soon coming to market. It is encouraging to see wool prices now having a more meaningful impact on growers’ bottom-line returns.
