

## PGG Wrightson 175-Year Anniversary Scholarship

1. The PGG Wrightson Limited (PGG Wrightson) 175-Year Scholarship is a one-off initiative established to commemorate PGG Wrightson's 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2026.
2. Two (2) \$2,000.00 scholarships will be awarded to two recipients, subject to these terms and conditions.

### Eligibility Criteria

3. Applications are only open to final-year students who are studying agriculture or horticulture at Lincoln University | Te Whare Wānaka o Aoraki, Massey University | Te Kunenga ki Pūrehuroa, the University of Otago | Ōtākou Whakaihu Waka, or the University of Waikato | Te Whare Wānanga o Waikato.
4. All applicants must complete their application online at [175 Year Scholarship Application | PGG Wrightson](#) and answer the following question (in no more than 1,000 words):

*"For 175 years, PGG Wrightson has helped New Zealand farmers and growers adapt to change. Looking ahead to the next 25 years, what do you believe will be the biggest challenge or opportunity facing New Zealand's agricultural and horticultural industries, and how would you build on the legacy of those who came before us to address it?"*

5. All applicants must submit their application by 5pm 31 July 2026.
6. Applications will be assessed by PGG Wrightson having regard to factors it considers relevant, including, but not limited to:
  - a. the quality, originality and clarity of the applicant's submission;
  - b. the applicant's understanding of New Zealand's agricultural and horticultural industries;
  - c. the relevance and practicality of the ideas presented; and
  - d. any other factors PGG Wrightson considers appropriate in its sole discretion.

PGG Wrightson is not required to apply any particular weighting to the above criteria and its decision is final.

7. No responsibility is accepted by PGG Wrightson for ineligible, lost or fraudulent applications. Ineligible applications include, but are not limited to, subscriptions received after 5pm Friday 31 July 2026 or entries that have been either partially or incorrectly completed.
8. After reviewing the applications, PGG Wrightson, in its sole discretion, will select two recipients each of whom will be awarded one scholarship. PGG Wrightson reserves the right not to award a scholarship in the event that no application meets the required standard.
9. Recipients will be notified that they have been awarded a scholarship in mid-August 2026.

### Scholarship Details

10. Two \$2,000.00 scholarships will be awarded. PGG Wrightson will pay each recipient \$2,000 into their nominated bank account. PGG Wrightson intends that each scholarship will go towards study costs.
11. Decisions of PGG Wrightson on all aspects of this scholarship (including the recipients that are awarded a scholarship) are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

12. As a condition of accepting a scholarship a recipient must confirm their eligibility and enrolment status and agree to the publicity and promotional requirements as outlined in these terms and conditions.
13. Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, PGG Wrightson excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of this scholarship, including, but not limited to; any entry that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after its receipt by PGG Wrightson) due to any reason.

## Privacy

14. PGG Wrightson collects and holds applicants' personal information for the purpose of reviewing scholarship applications, communicating with applicants and undertaking scholarship-related promotional activities with recipients of a scholarship. By submitting an application all applicants agree to grant PGW a non-exclusive, royalty free licence to reproduce, publish, quote from and promote all or part of their answer to the question contained in the application.
15. Prior to receiving a scholarship, a recipient will be required to show proof of identity, for example, their passport or driver's licence and proof of their current enrolment status (including where they are studying, what they are studying and that they are in their final year of study).
16. Each scholarship recipient consents to PGG Wrightson using their name, city of residence and/or photograph for promotional purposes in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration which may include:
  - a. Being publicly announced as a scholarship recipient through PGG Wrightson's communication channels, including social media platforms, media releases, and company publications.
  - b. Providing a photograph and a brief biographical information for promotional purposes.
  - c. Participating in interviews, recordings, photographs, video content relating to the scholarship.
  - d. Participating in an episode or segment of PGG Wrightson's *Blue Shed Diary* podcast, subject to mutual availability and reasonable notice.

## Other

17. PGG Wrightson reserves the right to cancel or amend any aspect of the 175-Year Anniversary Scholarship at any time.
18. Recipients of a scholarship will obtain their own tax advice in relation to any implications of receiving a scholarship.
19. Not open to PGG Wrightson employees and their immediate family members.
