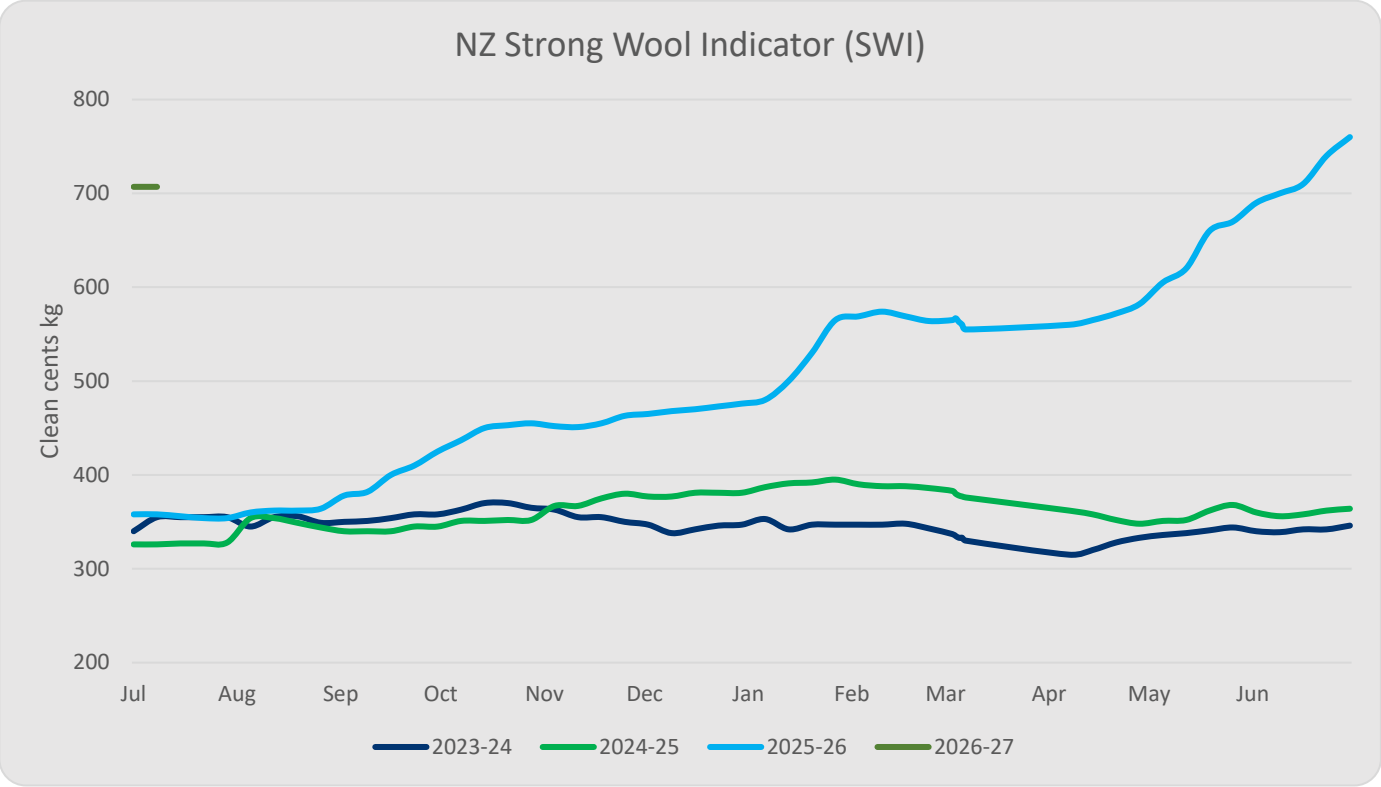

“ The first wool sale of the new season opened with a clear price adjustment compared with the final sale of last season two weeks earlier. Buyers were notably selective, with purchasing reflecting a tighter trading environment for crossbred types, particularly second-shear and lambs’ wool. After the strong price gains seen in recent months, some buyer resistance was to be expected. However, when viewed in context, current price levels remain broadly in line with where the market was around five weeks ago. Mid-micron wool was the standout, with a quality offering attracting solid support from the trade. - Dave Burridge, Auction Manager
