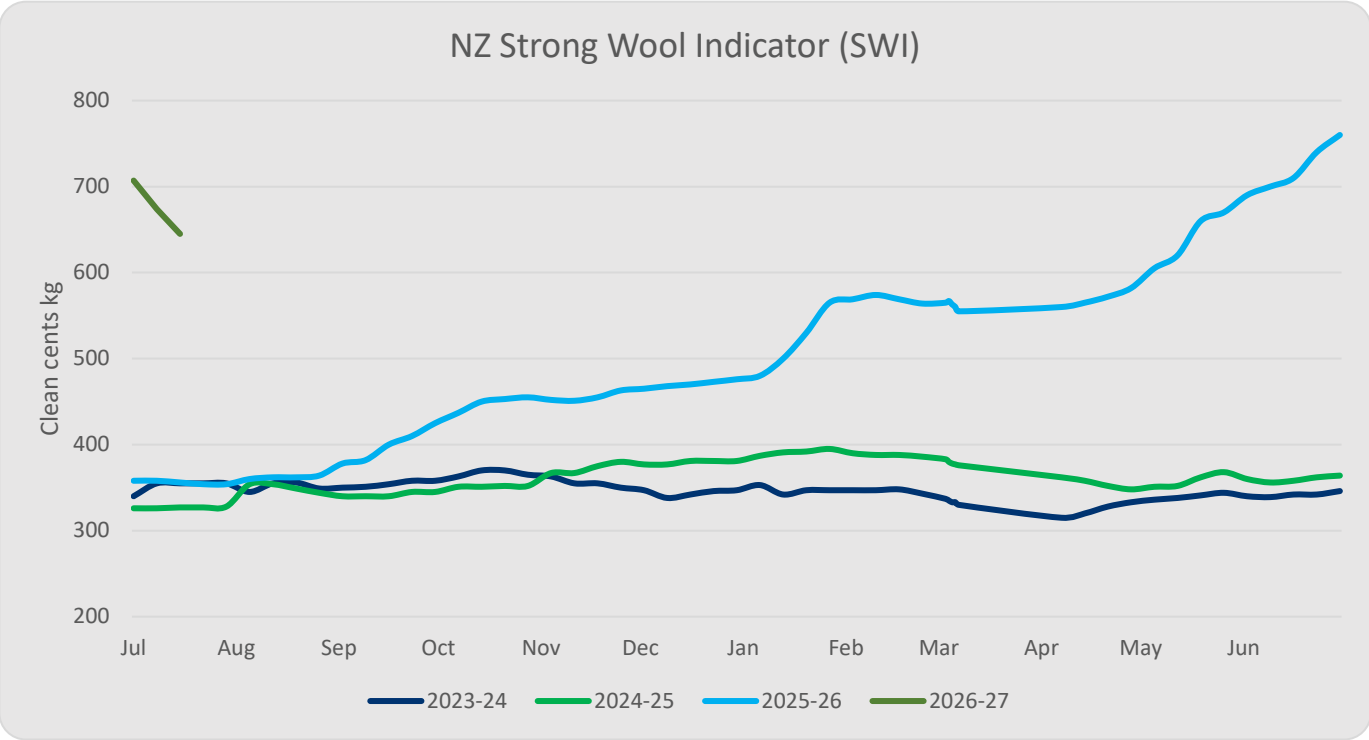

“ The market experienced strong buyer resistance today, with prices coming under significant downward pressure compared to last week’s auction. The largest declines were seen in second shear fleece wool and oddments. Rather than the expected levelling of prices following the strong gains in May and June, the market fell sharply. Most European mills are currently closed for summer holidays, and the markets of China and India appear to be taking a ‘wait and see’ approach before placing new orders. The speed and volatility of these price movements are creating challenging conditions for wool growers, brokers and exporters.
