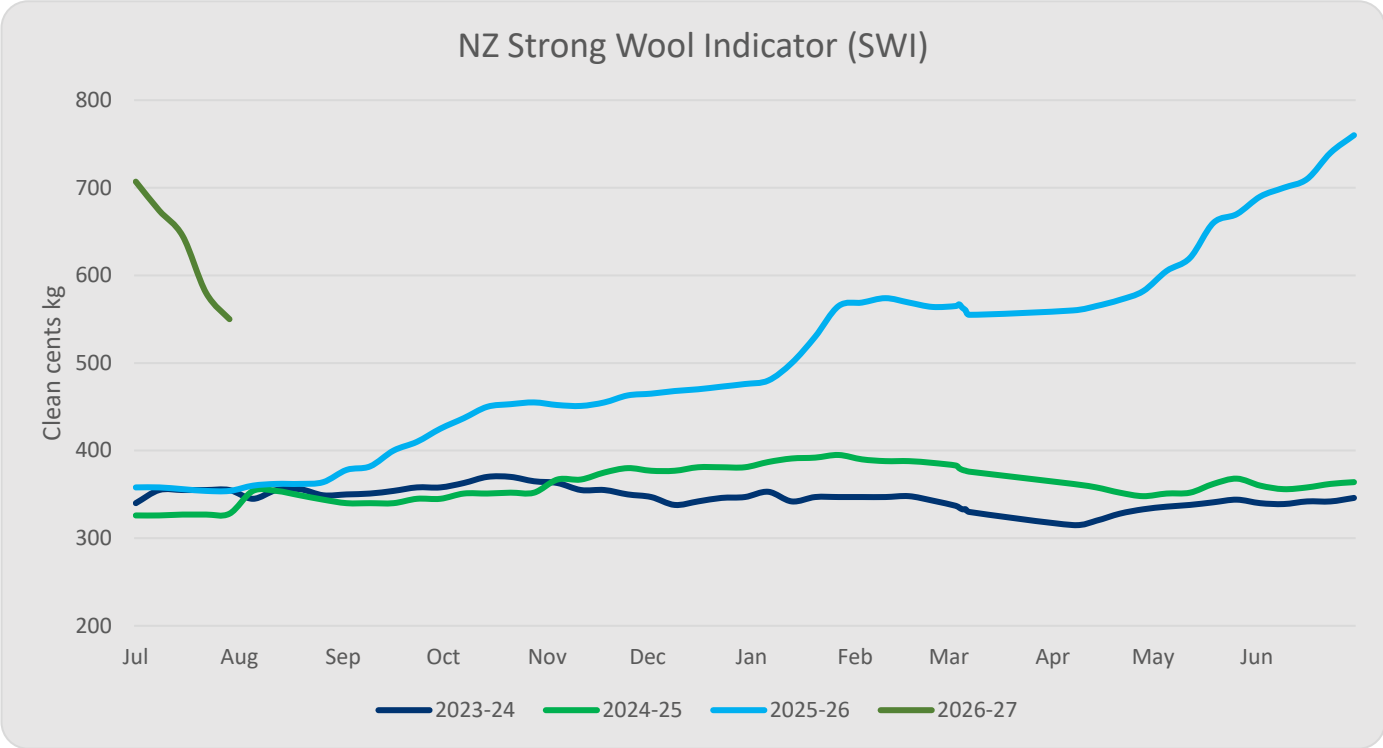

“ The crossbred market came under significant pressure this week, with a sharp decline in prices, particularly for second shear and oddment wool. Exporters have struggled to secure new sales following the elevated buying levels seen at the end of the season in June, while many overseas buyers are waiting for prices to stabilise before re-entering the market. Although the market has eased considerably, the underlying fundamentals of reduced wool supply remain unchanged. As pre-lamb shearing volumes begin to ease over the coming weeks, tighter supply is expected to support the market, although price volatility is likely to continue.
