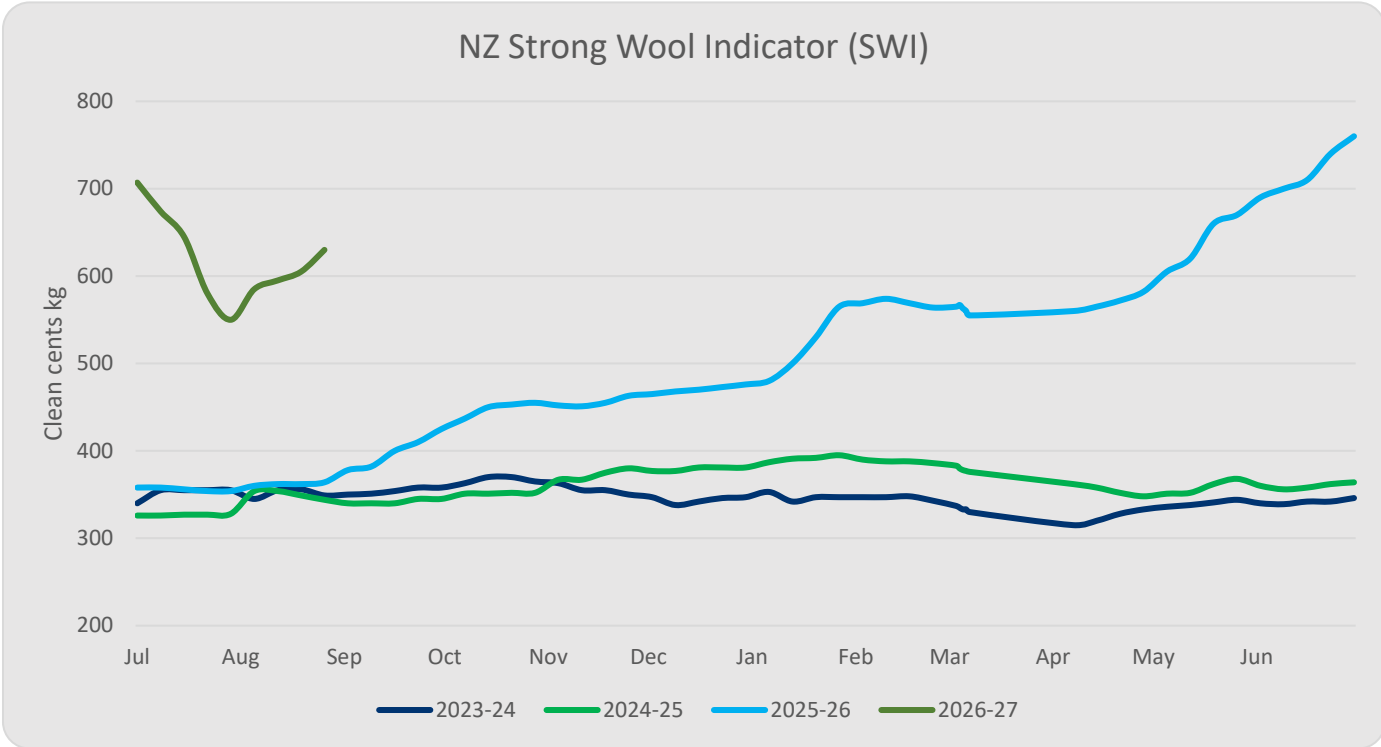

“ The N09 auction delivered a strong, fluid market, with demand outstripping the available supply. Competition was further strengthened by senior representatives from major Australian wool export houses, who added to the bidding on the auction floor. Significantly, these buyers purchased strong wool alongside their traditional fine wool requirements, a new development that broadened demand across the catalogue. All wool types and styles finished dearer, reflecting the depth and momentum of the market.
